Meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Holly Waldo, Marilla township supervisor.

Roll call found the following officer present, H. Waldo, Supervisor, M. Rybicki, Clerk, P. Ellis Treasurer, P. Taylor Trustee, K. Bingman Trustee.

Copies of the budget were given to the visitors present.

Due to the lower revenue we will be receiving this year the budget cuts this year will cause the township to no longer participate in the recycling program with Cleon & Springdale townships. Also unless there is educational programs that are very inexpensive there will be no educational programs this year.

The Supervisor rejected a raise the last two years but will receive one this year. There will be no other raises this year. Also our contracts for Fire and for the Assessor still have another year of coverage.

Alex Kuuttilla asked why if there is \$3,300.00 for road work in revenue only \$1,500.00 is scheduled in expenditures. Holly explained that we have that much but we do have to budget so that we can have enough when our township is require to match the road commissions spends for road work in our township.

There being no other questions meeting was closed at 6:50 p.m. to reopen for regular meeting at 7:00 p.m.
